WHAT IS A DBA?

The Doctorate in Business Administration (DBA) is a higher learning degree designed to develop business professionals who are skilled in researching practical business problems.

The focus is very much on researching in a practical context, as opposed to the more abstract, theory-driven research development that is provided by a PhD degree.

You will learn high level skills in conceptual and reflexive thinking. This will include the analysis of complex situations, the use of information systems for inquiry and the design implementation and monitoring of research inquiries within your organisation.

Throughout the DBA, you will be encouraged to contribute to research activities and culture, such as presenting findings at conferences. As research projects develop, there will also be opportunities to submit work for publication.







The standard duration of the Durham DBA at Fudan is six years, although students will be able to submit at any point after four and a half years subject to concession.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A Master's degree in a discipline related to business and management or finance from a recognised university or other institution of higher education; or equivalent qualifications or experience.
- A minimum of two years' business and management experience at an appropriate level.
- If English is not your first language you will need either an IELTS with an overall band score of 7.0 (with no element below 6.5) or a Pearson Test of English with an overall score of 70+ (with no element below 62). Please note that these can be no more than 2 years old at the month the programme commences eg. for a programme commencing in October 2018 the IELTS or PTE test must have been taken in or after October 2016. TOEFL iBT is no longer accepted as an English qualification for visa purposes.
