Entry requirements

Making the grade

The Durham MBA (Online) programme has the following entry criteria:

- Candidates must be able to demonstrate at least three years' continuous post-graduation work experience, in one or more positions with significant managerial responsibility.
- An upper second class Bachelor Degree or international equivalent.

Lack of formal qualifications is not necessarily a barrier to admission; managerial experience is also a key consideration for entry to our MBA programme.

In such cases, we may ask you to submit a portfolio of evidence demonstrating capability in areas such as management experience, including critical thinking skills and communication skills.

Additionally, candidates whose first language is not English will normally be required to demonstrate evidence of proficiency in English language as follows: a recent English language test score of 7.0 or above in IELTS with no element below 6.0, or 102 or above in TOEFL IBT with no element below 23 or an alternative University approved English language test.


