Title of proposed research topics:

- The historical role of audit in the public sector, including its relationship to Parliaments,
 Government bureaucracies and other stakeholders and the development of audit
 practices and techniques.
- Accounting, Auditing and Accountability Arrangements in the public sector and/or nonprofit sector.
- Localised institutional analysis of accounting, accountability and governance within not for profit entities, including but not limited to NGOs and public sector organisations.
