



- 3. Submit the required documents to CUHK



Student Visa

All students need a student visa to study in Hong Kong

(except holders of permanent Hong Kong ID cards)

- **1. Submit required documents to CUHK**
- 2. Hong Kong Immigration Department for processing (about 6-8 weeks)
- 3. CUHK will notify students to make a payment and download their student visa from the HK Immigration Department website
- 4. Show your student visa to the immigration officer when you arrive at the HK International Airport


